 - On 18 December 2020, FEAD provided feedback to the EC Public Consultation on a Draft Delegated Act on Sustainable finance – EU classification system for green investments, which is published <u>here</u>.
 - On 31 December 2020, FEAD provided feedback to the EC Consultation on the 8th Environmental Action Programme (Proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on a General Union Environment Action Programme to 2030), which is published <u>here</u>.

Monitoring of EU Institutions

Life of EU institutions

- The Compromise Amendments between the political groups regarding the report of the ENVI Committee of the European Parliament on the new Circular Economy Action Plan were leaked this week.
- Regarding Amendments 26 and 28 regarding Paragraphs 31 and 34 – 34a of the report respectively, we pointed out to EP that:
 - a cap on residual waste should be deleted from the text: Residual waste has no legal definition, and a general cap is very problematic as it is not feasible in practice. A cap on residual waste is not needed as long as recycling targets are in place. Measures for tackling residual waste are sufficiently mentioned in Paragraph 34a.
 - the call for harmonisation of selective collection schemes should also be deleted from the text: We do not see why local schemes for selective collection should be harmonised across EU (frequency, colour of the bags/bins etc). Taking into account different regional or local conditions is key for success, and for not impacting well-functioning existing systems, as mentioned in the compromise amendment.
 - Please note that the proposed text in Paragraph 34 on landfills now reads: "Member States must strengthen prevention and preparation for reuse, increase highquality recycling and move away from landfilling waste, while minimising the need for incineration, in line with the waste hierarchy".
 - The last meeting of shadow rapporteurs took place today, January 15. As a reminder, the vote in the ENVI committeewill take place on January 25 and in the EP Plenary on February 8.
- EU action to reduce plastic waste: exchange with the Court of Auditors.
 - EP CONT and ENVI committees held a joint <u>exchange</u>(Thursday 7 January) with the European Court of Auditorson their review of the EU's response to the growing problem of plastic waste.
 - Plastic waste represents a sizeable share of total waste with packaging in particular accounting for over 60 % of plastic waste. The review examines issues such as packaging

design, extended producer responsibility, recycling, shipment and trafficking of waste. It provides key findings to improve the implementation of the 2018 Plastics Strategy.

- The minutes of the Fourth Informal Working Group Meeting on ADR and Waste, which was held on 19 November 2020, are now available <u>here</u>.
- In relation to issues 2.2 and 2.5 of the minutes, FEAD will conduct further work on a clear and comprehensive document presenting a benchmark on the existing national derogations classified by relevant issues. We will keep you posted on how this work proceeds.
- On 17 December 2020, FEAD submitted <u>document 61</u> for the Spring Joint Meeting's session with modifications agreed during the last two informal working group meetings.

Press Review & Reports

- ZWE study on reusable packaging
 - The civil society organization Zero Waste Europe (ZWE) published a new <u>study</u> (December 2020) entitled "REUSABLE Vs SINGLE-USE PACKAGING: A review of environmental impacts" and finding that reusable packaging has 85% lower carbon emissions than singleuse alternatives.
