#### • FEAD Press Release on the updated EU Industrial Strategy

- On 5 May, the European Commission <u>updated the EU</u> <u>Industrial Strategy</u> to reflect the post-covid era. <u>FEAD issued a Press Release</u> welcoming the revised strategy and reiterating some of our key messages and expectations stemming from it.

- FEAD meetings with MEPs on the proposed Regulation for Batteries
  - FEAD continues its campaigning on the new proposed Regulation for Batteries and Waste Batteries. This week we met with the Assistants of MEPs Schieder (S&D, Austria), Sidl (S&D, Austria), and Danti(Renew, Italy).
  - IPDATED competences of EP Committees: Please see here the updates on the competences of the European Parliament Committees (ENVI Lead. IMCO, TRAN, ITRE Associated) on the proposal for a Batteries' Regulation, based on the DECISION OF THE CONFERENCE OF PRESIDENTS (29 April 2021). Please note that TRAN Committee's competences are still not specified.

# **Ongoing Surveys and Consultations**

- Sustainable Products Initiative:
  - As one of the main deliverables of the Circular Economy Action Plan, the Sustainable Products Initiative (SPI) foresees the revision and extension of the scope of the Eco-design Directive together with other legislative or nonlegislative proposals if needed. The legislative proposal can be expected by the end of the year (Q4 2021).

- The Commission has <u>published</u> a new initiative Public Consultation (questionnaire) on Sustainable Products. (EC deadline for feedback is 09 June 2021 midnight Brussels time). FEAD has prepared a draft response to the questionnaire <u>here</u> and a draft note with additional comments to stress some aspects that are missing/should be further addressed in the process <u>here</u>. Please send us your feedback on the two FEAD drafts by 23 May 2021 COB.
- A first workshop has been held on 15 April by the consultant **Trinomics** to jump-start consultations with targeted stakeholders on a number of aspects of products' policies (see the slides <u>here</u>). In particular, the following workshops are foreseen (selected according to our interest):
  - on Digital Products' Passports: 29 April 2021
  - on the Revision of Ecodesign rules: 17 May 2021
  - on the assessment of the overall impact of economic and administrative impacts of the policy options: 20 May 2021
  - on the development of the measures for monitoring and evaluation of the SPI implementation and for market surveillance and enforcement: 27 May 2021.

#### • EC Consultation on the revision of the REACH Regulation:

- The Commission has **<u>published</u>** a new initiative -Roadmap for the **revision of the REACH Regulation**.
  - The European Green Deal sets out the ambition to reach zero pollution for a toxic-free environment. As part of this ambition, the chemicals strategy for sustainability announces actions to better protect people and the environment against hazardous chemicals and to encourage innovation to develop safe and sustainable alternatives. Achieving these goals requires revising the rules governing the registration, evaluation, authorisation, and restriction of chemicals in the EU.

FEAD has prepared a draft response to the roadmap <u>here</u>. Please, send us your feedback by the 25th of May COB (EC deadline for feedback is 1 June 2021 - midnight Brussels time). Please find the Inception Impact Assessment <u>here</u>.

#### • EC Consultation on the revision of the CLP Regulation:

- The Commission
  has <u>published</u> a new initiative Roadmap for the Revision
  of the EU legislation on hazard classification, labelling
  and packaging of chemicals (CLP Regulation).
  - For the implementation of the Green Deal, the chemicals strategy for sustainability sets out a number of actions that require a targeted revision of the Regulation on the classification, labelling and packaging of chemical substances and mixtures. Various options for revision will be analysed in an impact assessment and, based on the results, the Commission will present legislative proposals for a revision of both the enacting terms of and the annexes to that Regulation.
- FEAD will prepare a draft response to the roadmap and share it with you for your feedback in the coming days. (EC deadline for feedback is 1 June 2021 - midnight Brussels time). Please find the Inception Impact Assessment <u>here</u>.
- <u>EC Consultation on the ecodesign and energy labelling</u> working plan 2020-2024:
  - The Commission has <u>published</u> a new initiative Roadmap for the ecodesign and energy labelling working plan 2020-2024.
    - Ecodesign and energy labelling rules have been one of the EU's most effective tools in promoting energy efficiency, contributing around half of the energy savings target for 2020. In addition, ecodesign rules have started to address the more efficient use of materials in designing products. The 2020-2024 ecodesign and energy labelling working plan will set

priorities for the adoption of product-specific legislation in this field.

- <u>EC Consultation on the revision of the Urban Wastewater</u> <u>Treatment Directive (UWWTD):</u>
  - The Commission has <u>published</u> a new initiative Public Consultation (questionnaire) on the revision of the Urban Wastewater Treatment Directive (UWWTD). FEAD will prepare a draft response to the questionnaire and share it with you for your feedback in the coming weeks. (EC deadline for feedback is 21 July 2021 - midnight Brussels time). #### • Draft SUP Directive Guidelines:

- The European Commission has published an <u>updated draft of the Single-Use Plastics (SUP)</u>
   <u>Directive Guidelines</u>, which should be approved by the Commission in the second half of May 2021.
  - Apparently, manufacturers have some concerns over the transposal and implementation date, which is set by July 2021, and are asking the EC to consider the deadline.
  - SFor our sector, we don't see any particular issue, but please send us your feedback as soon as possible, if you find any matter of concern.
- <u>Webinars on the Impact Assessment study of the Packaging</u> and Packaging Waste Directive :
  - FEAD has been invited to a series of webinars on the Impact Assessment study of the Packaging and Packaging Waste Directive (PPWD), where Eunomia will share the first results of the impact assessment.
